Footnotes

COLD COLD WOMAN (GB) three deep early, stalked outside a rival or off the rail, bid outside the runner-up leaving the final turn and through a stiff drive and gamely but narrowly prevailed under urging. SECRET CHARM (IRE) three deep on the first turn, angled in and stalked a bit off the rail then inside, split rivals to gain the lead into the last turn, continued just off the rail, fought back through a long drive and continued gamely to the wire. BENEFICIAL BARTOK went up inside to duel for command, fought back into the final turn, weakened in the stretch but held third. SANTA CANDIDA (ARG) between horses early, chased a bit off the rail or inside, came out on the final turn and three deep into the stretch and just missed the show. I CAN YODELE three deep early, alternated in front outside a rival, was three wide into the final turn, angled in some on that bend and weakened.
