SHE'S VERY RARE chased on the inside down the backstretch, moved closer into the turn, saved ground around the turn, waited for room leaving the quarter pole and nearing the stretch, split horses at the top of the stretch to take command, drifted out in the final furlong and won clear. DISH THE DIRT settled at the back of the pack in the run down the backstretch, began to move up on the outside around the turn, came into the stretch four wide, rallied on the outside in the final furlong and gained the place. FORTY DATES raced three deep into the turn and outside the winner around the turn, kept to her task in the lane and was a clear third at the wire. WARREN'S ROSE moved up to duel for the lead on the inside down the backstretch, retained a narrow advantage to the top of the lane, gave up command and weakened on the inside through the final furlong. CAPALATTE chased on the outside came three deep into the stretch and failed to make an impact in the lane. APPEALING RESUME sped to the lead on the outside leaving the gate, dueled with WARREN'S ROSE down the backstretch and around the turn and weakened between horses in the final furlong. GUIDED WAVE was in tight quarters between horses entering the turn, fell back on the turn and weakened in the stretch drive.
