Footnotes

NASHOBA (IRE) bobbled at the break, sped between horses to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, battled outside a rival into and on the second turn, shook free again into the stretch, drifted out in the lane but held gamely under urging, then was taken in hand at the wire. GRACE AVENUE stalked the early pace inside, bid inside the winner and dueled into and on the second turn, was shuffled back some nearing the stretch, continued inside and held second. GARDEN IN THE RAIN (FR) close up tracking the pace a bit off the rail, came out for room nearing the stretch and bested the others. MILLIE'S QUEST well placed stalking the pace outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. GOT THE VOTES three deep early, chased outside a rival, clipped heels approaching the half mile pole, then angled in and dropped back. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference nearing the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the videotape failed to substantiate the claim.
