DREAM'S (CHI) bobbled at the start, was between horses early, stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter past midstretch, gained the lead under left handed urging in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. RED TOP (IRE) threw her head just after the start, pulled her way along inside chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and closed gamely. PENNY'S FORTUNE sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside and held on well but was overtaken late. ROUND HEELS (IRE) pulled her way along three deep then stalked outside a rival, came out into the stretch and finished with interest. SPARKLING HUMOR saved ground in a good striking position stalking the pace, remained inside in the stretch and lacked the necessary response. GRAT settled inside chasing the pace, came off the rail on the second turn and could not summon the needed late kick. NAVAJA (NZ) chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally.
