Footnotes

TAHOE YODELER broke out onto foes, sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then inside on the turn, came out from the whip in upper stretch and won clear under urging. CALL ME LATER in tight early, had speed between foes to stalk the pace then continued just off the rail on the backstretch and

turn, could not match the winner but held second. BEER FRIDAY had speed between foes then was in a bit tight early, angled in and stalked inside the rest of the way and edged rivals for third. SPUD SPIVENS steadied along the rail early and fell back some, stalked inside to the stretch, came out in midstretch and just missed the show. SWISS HERO bumped at the start, was in a good position chasing the pace between horses on the backstretch and turn and lacked the needed rally. GRAYDLE'S RED had speed outside then stalked outside foes, continued four wide on the turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. RED MOUNTAIN bumped at the start, settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SWISS LIGHTNING squeezed between horses early, chased three deep to the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. OPINIONATED broke slowly, settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. DODGER squeezed back at the start, settled outside then off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. AIRWAR bumped early, had speed between foes then stalked the pace, fell back outside a rival on the turn and weakened.
