Footnotes

MEGA HEAT close up stalking the pace inside, waited off heels leaving the second turn, came out a bit and lacked room behind foes in midstretch, angled back to the rail, got through, took the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under steady handling. KILLER BEAR settled four wide then three deep on the first turn, chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and just got the place four wide on the line. BLUEGRASS REWARD stalked three deep on the first turn then outside a rival, bid three wide into the stretch, bid outside foes in midstretch and continued willingly between horses late. HOLLADAY ROAD pulled a bit and chased between foes then just off the rail, split rivals on the second turn, waited a bit leaving that turn, came out some in the stretch and also went on well between horses late. ROMEO ROYALE sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, came a bit off the rail and fought back in the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and was outfished. OBSESS prompted the pace outside a rival, fought back between horses in the stretch, weakened late, did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. HE BE FIRE N ICE pulled inside then came out into the backstretch, chased outside a rival, angled three deep into the stretch, steadied when crowded a sixteenth out and lacked the needed rally. QUILLLOTANO settled a bit off the rail then inside, saved ground, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. ROARING TIMES chased between horses then a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn, came out a bit in the stretch and weakened. GREEN CARD JAMES settled just off the inside, angled in leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the second turn and did not rally.
