CHARM A SONG stalked the pace a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, angled in approaching the bend, bid inside in the stretch, gained the lead past midstretch and proved best under urging. GOODBYE GAMBLER dueled inside on the backstretch, inched away on the turn, came off the rail into the stretch and could not match the winner. PLEASE DEAR PLEASE chased between horses then off the rail, angled in for the turn and edged a rival for third. IONIA stalked off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and was edged for the show. SLEW CITY LILY prompted the pace outside the runner-up then stalked off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. BALTIC NATIONS broke out a bit, chased outside on the backstretch, angled in on the turn and did not rally. KELLI LEE settled inside chasing the pace, came out on the turn and into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip in midstretch and lacked the needed response. DREAM OF SUMMER steadied while racing erratically on the backstretch, dropped back between foes and was eased in the stretch.
