HEAVY TRAFFIC sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, kicked clear on the turn and drew off under a brisk hand ride while being shown the whip. DIXIE GLOW off a bit slowly, went up inside to stalk the pace, continued inside on the turn and in the stretch and was second best. SAVE broke slowly, moved up between horses, stalked three deep leaving the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and bested the others. BONANZA TWO off slowly and in tight early, settled out from the inside, angled in some on the turn and was not a threat. MARGIE'S WILDCAT stalked between horses then outside a rival and weakened in the stretch. FUSEOUT steadied between horses and dropped back off the rail on the backstretch, continued just off the fence on the turn and did not rally. GODGAVEMEWINGS chased outside, dropped back leaving the backstretch and on the turn and was not a threat. SHERIFF JORDAN broke slowly and steadied, settled off the rail, went four wide on the turn and three deep into the stretch and failed to menace. R J'S WAY broke inward and a bit slowly, moved up inside on the backstretch, came out nearing the half mile marker, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. BIG SPEEDY chased between horses, steadied off heels nearing the half mile pole, lugged out and steadied again early on the turn and also weakened.
