SHU BIZ DANNY had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, drifted in under urging in midstretch and drew clear. LONE JUSTICE stalked the pace outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and held second. ARMENIAN STAR allowed to settle outside then off the rail, came out on the turn and six wide into the stretch and gained the show late. THE UNUSUAL ONE bobbled and broke out a bit, chased between horses, was in a bit tight into the turn, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, split horses in midstretch, angled in some and was edged for third. THE WOLLAN stalked the pace inside, came out off the heels of the winner in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. CRISPY COREY close up forcing or stalking the pace under a hold between horses, continued alongside a rival into the stretch, angled in off heels in midstretch and could not offer the necessary response. CRESTATORRE broke slightly in the air, came out and went between horses to stalk on the backstretch and turn, was four wide into the stretch and did not rally. WARREN'S GRIDLOCK veered out at the start, settled off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, swung out into the stretch and was not a threat. BREAKMARK prompted the pace outside then alongside the winner and weakened in the stretch. FRANCONI broke a bit slowly, drifted in and steadied early, settled a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and was outrun.
