Footnotes

DOMONATION chased off the rail then inside on the turn, moved up to bid along the fence in the stretch, battled under urging along the inside and got up on the wire. MAGIC BEAM chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in and bid alongside a rival to gain the lead past midstretch, battled outside the winner in deep stretch and was edged late. BERGMAN settled outside then three deep leaving the backstretch and on the turn, came out five wide into the stretch and finished with interest. TRUELEE SCRAPPIN broke through the gate before the start, settled inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and again in upper stretch and had a late bid. TIZ POINT stalked outside a rival, continued outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and was outfinished. TONES (IRE) settled off the rail chasing the pace, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch then found the rail again on the drive and finished with some interest. GUTSHOT STRAIGHT settled outside then alongside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. COURTSIDE had speed between foes then stalked a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. CHASING THE HEAT broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GUIDOPANZINI had speed outside then three deep, stalked outside a rival, came out into the stretch and weakened. STREET CAR had good early speed and inched away on the backstretch, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, fought back in midstretch but weakened in the final furlong. BLUE JAY ATTACK allowed to settle off the pace outside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response.
