LEADING LIGHT was outrun a bit off the rail, swung out wide into the stretch and rallied gamely under urging to get up late. EXCITE, settled outside a rival, went four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch, gained the lead just past midstretch, inched away but was caught nearing the wire. SHARP EYES, chased the leaders toward the inside, came out three deep to split rivals nearing midway on the turn, waited a bit behind foes into the stretch, came out in midstretch and finished with some interest for third. KALOOKAN ANGEL, vied for command between rivals, put a head in front in midstretch but weakened late. MONEY IN THE SHEET, dueled on a short lead inside but a bit off the rail, battled between foes in midstretch, then also weakened. COOKIN VICKIE, close up off the rail on the backstretch, dropped back between foes on the turn and also weakened. PERT LAURA, angled in and saved ground, moved up into the stretch, bid inside in midstretch, then weakened, was unsaddled near the clubhouse turn but was walked off. BOX OFFICE GIRL forced the pace three deep, came four wide into the stretch, was a bit crowded while dropping back in midstretch and had little left.
