TIGER BLITZ had speed outside a rival then stalked off the rail, bid alongside that one leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched clear under left handed urging and held gamely. CHOCOLATE CANDY was in a good position chasing the pace outside a rival to the stretch and finished with interest but could not catch the winner. ORTHODOX sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened some but held third. JOKING SAM settled off the pace inside then a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and bested the others. LIFELINE three deep on the first turn, lugged in some on the backstretch and chased outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, lugged in again in midstretch and lacked a rally. POKER DAVE settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. WORTH REPEATING chased between horses, was a bit crowded early on the backstretch, continued inside then a bit off the rail, was in tight in midstretch and did not rally. SEVEN LUCKY J'S angled in and saved ground stalking the pace and weakened in the stretch.
