DELAHOOSSEE chased outside a rival then inside on the second turn, came out in midstretch and rallied between horses under some urging and good handling to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. BIG COZZ a bit fractious in the gate, stalked inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch, bid three wide in deep stretch and continued willingly. UZZIAH sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the backstretch and second turn, fought back to regain a short lead past midstretch and held third. RIO DE VINO chased inside, came out into the stretch and found his best stride late to be edged for the show. BATTLE SCHOOL stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside a rival on the backstretch, took a short lead on the second turn, dueled on a slim advantage past midstretch and weakened late. FLAMMABLE BOOM broke slowly, settled off the pace inside to the stretch and was outrun. DR. CHEN chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, dropped back into and through the stretch and gave way.
