### Footnotes

BRIGHTON STAR chased a bit off the rail or briefly between foes on the backstretch, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up three deep late. KIMNJET chased outside then off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and rallied between foes in the late stages. ZNELLE dueled between horses, gained a slim lead on the turn, inched clear a sixteenth out and was caught late. SAILORS BROTHER had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. KHAL DROGO saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and again past midstretch and lacked the needed rally. NEW ORDER dueled three deep, fought back until past midstretch, then weakened. PRINCE DR stalked off the rail then outside a rival on the turn and weakened in the stretch. UNUSUAL DON stalked off the rail then three deep, continued outside on the turn and three wide into the stretch and weakened. IM JUAN'S BROTHER broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace along the inside to the stretch and was not a threat. STORMIN settled off the rail or outside a rival, drifted out while being pulled up leaving the turn and was walked off.
