RAHY'S QUACKERJACK went up inside to vie for command, inched away on the turn, responded when challenged in the stretch and won clear under good handling. IMPRESSIVE GRADES, saved ground, moved up on the turn, came out into the stretch to loom a threat but could not match the winner. BOTTLE OF RUM was slow into stride, came off the rail early, angled in on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and gained the show. SPINELESSJELLYFISH settled outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed response. MEADOW PRAYER, bobbled at the start, raced close up between horses early, dropped back and stalked three deep to the stretch, then drifted in through the drive and weakened. GREAT ASSET outrun toward the inside, swung out wide into the stretch and failed to menace. BRILLIANTLY, wide early, continued off the rail, angled in some on the turn and was not a threat. LORD CUNNINGHAM close up outside IMPRESSIVE GRADES early and between foes into the turn, weakened. CLASSY SHEIKH sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled outside the winner, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
