CARDIO ROYALE settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under a tap of the whip and energetic handling to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. AMP AND ADRENALIN pulled and angled in to stalk the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn, bid between horses into and through the stretch, put a head in front a sixteenth out and just held second. HURRY HOME CLOVER three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, went three wide on the second turn and into the stretch, bid outside foes into and through the drive and edged for the place. AFFLICATION pulled and angled in early, dueled inside, inched away on the second turn, fought back inside into and through the stretch and was outfinished late. SALAH CHAMP saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and in upper stretch and finished with some interest but was outkicked. FRENEMY chased outside a rival then off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SEVEN BRIDGES steadied when crowded at the start, pulled alongside a rival then outside leaving the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch, drifted in and could not offer the necessary response. BARDY settled a bit off the rail then inside, went outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. HOOSIER DIDDY angled in and saved ground off the pace, came a bit off the rail on the backstretch, angled back to the inside and weakened in the stretch. LOCALSUCCESS had good early speed and angled in, dueled outside a rival, dropped back between horses on the

second turn and weakened.
