HOLY LUTE angled in on the first turn and stalked inside, came out midway on the second turn, bid between foes, took a short lead into the stretch and held on gamely under urging. FURY KAPCORI three deep into the first turn, stalked off the rail or outside a rival, bid three wide on the second turn and into the stretch, battled outside the winner through the drive and continued willingly but could not get by. TIZ A MINISTER angled in and saved ground off the pace, split rivals into the stretch and rallied late for the show. TREE OF LIFE settled off the rail chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and was edged late for third. PATAKY KID angled in on the first turn and settled inside, came out on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MANANDO sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the backstretch, duled from the rail on the second turn and weakened in the lane. R S WATSON came off the rail in the run to the first turn, went between horses then prompted the pace outside a rival, dropped back some into the second turn, steadied sharply between horses while weakening midway on that turn and had little left for the stretch. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident on the second turn but made no change when they ruled the trouble to R S WATSON did not alter the original order of finish.
