Footnotes

FAIR KATE angled in and pressed the early pace a bit off the rail, dueled inside into and on the turn, inched clear into the stretch and proved best under a strong hand ride. DAZZLING DIAMONDS stalked the pace along the inside to the stretch, came out in midstretch and picked up the place. ALESSANDRIA settled outside then off the rail, angled in approaching the turn, moved up inside early on the bend, came four wide into the stretch and just held third between foes late. LA OTRA NINA bobbled slightly in the opening strides, settled a bit off the rail, came out some on the turn and put in a late bid at a minor award. DARE BUNNY well placed chasing the leaders three deep to the stretch, angled inward past midstretch and lacked the needed late response. MAURA'S DIAMOND sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled outside the winner nearing and on the turn and weakened in the stretch. THREE ROCKS close up stalking the pace between horses to the stretch, angled to the inside in the lane and also weakened.
