HAWK'S TOP GUN sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, drifted out a bit into the stretch and again in midstretch and held on gamely under urging. IBN AL HAITHAM (GB) bobbled at the start, chased outside a rival, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, drifted in a bit in midstretch and could not get by. HIGH THUNDER broke out and a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, split rivals twice on the second turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. SWEET STEPPER close up stalking the pace outside a rival or off the rail, bid between horses on the second turn and into the stretch, was a bit crowded while weakening in midstretch and dropped back. FULL MANDATE settled outside, made a mild move forward on three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch but lacked a further response. AMERICAN SYSTEM bobbled and broke inward, saved ground stalking the pace and weakened in the stretch. NATURES CANDY well placed stalking the winner along the inside, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
