GOOD COP BAD COP stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and rallied under some urging to prove best. HE DOES dueled between horses then outside a rival, gained the advantage nearing midstretch, drifted in some past the eighth pole and inched away but could not hold off the winner. BETTOR ROYALTY chased outside a rival then three deep on the turn and into the stretch, came out in upper stretch and gained the show. GHOST MEMO stalked off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed response. MATT THE MIGHTY had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail then inside, fought back on the turn and to midstretch, was in a bit tight behind the runner-up past the eighth pole and weakened. ARCHIE'S DREAM chased a bit off the rail then between horses on the turn and did not rally. QUILLOTA stalked off the inside on the backstretch and turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and weakened. AMMANN allowed to settle off the rail, went four wide into the turn and three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. CALIFORNIA POWER bobbled at the start, saved ground off the pace, moved up inside on the turn, remained along the rail and weakened in the stretch.
