SWEET GAZELLE wide in the chute, angled in outside a rival then chased a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in but gained a short lead between horses, drifted out under left handed urging late but held gamely. CHELCEE'S HOPE chased off the rail then outside a rival, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied outside in the stretch, drifted out in deep stretch and again late and just missed. TIZ THE GAME broke slowly, settled off the rail, went three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, waited off heels in midstretch, came out for room, was in tight off heels again in deep stretch and finished gamely. STORMIN LUCY angled in and stalked inside, awaited room in midstretch, got through along the rail and continued willingly but was outkicked. VELVETY SMOOTH pulled early, chased a bit off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, steadied off heels in deep stretch but finished with interest. ENCHANTING LADY angled in and chased outside a rival, was between horses on the second turn, came out in the stretch and put in a late bid between foes. TRIPLE STRAND sped to the early lead outside a rival, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, held on gamely past midstretch but weakened late. TIZADREAM stalked inside then outside a rival, bid three deep on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. AURORING STAR pulled her way along inside then stalked a bit off the rail, bid between horses leaving the second turn

but also weakened in the drive. EVENT TO REMEMBER saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back into the stretch and also weakened. Following a stewards' inquiry, CHELCEE'S HOPE was disqualified and placed fifth for interference in deep stretch.
