Footnotes

SOUTH BAY SCOTY settled outside or off the rail, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied to the lead in midstretch and drew clear under some urging and steady handling. STORM BRAVE stalked between horses, moved up inside on the turn, bid outside a rival leaving the turn and between foes into the stretch and was second best. GRILLIN N CHILLN saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the turn and in the stretch and picked up the show. HE'S INVINCIBLE close up stalking the pace three deep on the backstretch and outside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. CARSON'S COPPER went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away into the turn, battled inside leaving the turn, came off the rail in the stretch and also weakened. SUIT YOURSELF sped to the early lead off the rail then dueled outside a rival, stalked alongside the runner-up midway on the turn, continued off the inside into the stretch and had little left. SKYSPY stalked a bit off the rail then inside, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
