CHARM THE MAKER chased the pace on the off the rail down the backstretch, moved closer on the outside around the turn, took over the lead three deep approaching the sixteenth marker and drew clear under left handed urging. FLY SOLO chased the pacesetter three deep down the backstretch and outside a rival around the turn, was between horses in midstretch, went willingly to the wire but was no match for the winner. INDECISE chased between horses down the backstretch then inside a rival around the turn, was in a bit tight while searching for room at the eighth pole, came out late and was a clear third at the wire. STORMY RANDIE was off slowly and ducked in at the start, chased off the rail down the backstretch and around the turn, remained outside for the stretch drive and passed tiring foes in the final furlong. CAVALLETTA was sent from the inside leaving the gate, pulled her way along on the inside down the backstretch, angled off the rail around the turn, was asked for her best mid-turn and weakened in the stretch drive. MY BASHERT was fractious in the gate and delayed the start, sped to the lead, opened a clear advantage inside down the backstretch and around the turn and weakened on the inside through the final furlong.
