U. C. MERCED TWO dueled between horses then stalked off the rail, had the rider lose the whip leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch and rallied under energetic handling to get up four wide late. THRICE THE VICE dueled inside, inched away in the stretch off the rail and was caught between horses late. DON ELIAS M. (MEX) dueled between horses then outside the winner, had that one slip away briefly in the stretch and continued willingly between foes late. PURSE LUVA a bit slow to begin, went up inside to chase the pace, saved ground on the turn and rallied inside in the stretch. RAINGEAR pulled between foes then chased off the rail, swung five wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. CERTIFIED DIAMOND stalked outside, came four wide into the stretch and continued willingly but was outfinished. MIND THE MINISTER bobbled at the start, settled off the rail then inside, came out four wide into the stretch, angled inward in midstretch and was in tight between foes late. COLOURSOFTHEGLEN (IRE) chased outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. SO BEHOLD chased between horses, angled in some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ALABAMA BOY saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and weakened. MOSSAD allowed to settle outside then alongside a rival, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. A CAT NAMED SNIPE prompted the pace between horses then stalked outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.
