Footnotes

BIG SON OF A GUN saved ground around the first turn, chased on the inside down the backstretch and into the second turn, came out leaving the second turn, rallied between horses and was up for the score. LAMM was between horses into the first turn, chased inside a rival into the second turn, swung out leaving the second turn, entered the stretch four wide, came in a bit in the final furlong and was a clear second at the wire. ALL DE VICTORS was three deep around the first turn, stalked off the rail, was three wide around the second turn and into the lane, bid for command at the top of the stretch, took a short lead and weakened in the final furlong between horses. JOE CARL angled over to save ground around the first turn, chased on the inside, swung out for the stretch drive and improved his position. JIM'S DECISION was between horses around the first turn, stalked off the rail, came into the stretch between horses, and weakened on the inside through the final furlong. ROYAL IMPORT (GB) chased on the inside throughout the journey and lacked the necessary rally. APPLY was fractious in the gate, broke a step slowly, chased outside a rival into the second turn, came three wide into the stretch, angled inward in the drive and did not threaten. STREET CAR sped to the early lead, opened a clear advantage on the backstretch, was challenged at the top of the stretch and gave way between horses in the final furlong.
