FED BIZ sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, fought back when headed in the stretch, regained a slim advantage under left handed urging in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. JIMMY CREED went up outside the winner leaving the first turn to press the pace, dueled alongside that rival, gained a short lead in the stretch, battled willingly to the wire but was outgamed. UNUSUAL HEATWAVE a bit crowded at the start, chased outside a rival, went three deep leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the others. SHAUN WASHINGTON broke out a bit, saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, drifted out from the whip some in midstretch, was straightened and lacked a further response. PRIVATE ZONE also broke out a bit, pulled between horses and steadied in the early stages while being taken back, chased off the rail, went between horses leaving the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.
