Footnotes

AMERICAN TANKER between foes early, chased outside a rival, came out some in the stretch, rallied under urging to the lead a sixteenth out and held gamely between foes late. MONEY TALKER settled inside chasing the pace, came out on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and finished well. BIG BANE THEORY stalked the pace inside, split foes early on the second turn, came out three wide into the stretch and rallied between rivals late. GREAT RISING STAR a bit washy at the gate, was sent between horses then angled in and set the pace inside, opened up on the backstretch, remained clear in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch and was outfinished late. SUMERIAN a bit slow to begin, chased between horses then off the rail leaving the backstretch, came out four wide into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. WARRIOR'S RIDGE had speed three deep then stalked off the rail or outside a rival, angled in leaving the second turn and lacked the needed rally. SLEW'S FLASH brushed the gate in a bit of a slow start, saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival leaving the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. TRIPLE JEOPARDY squeezed a bit at the start, pulled and angled in alongside a rival chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, angled in again and was not a threat. WHITE STAR LINE chased three deep then outside, moved up three wide leaving the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn, dropped back in the stretch and weakened. HOMETOWN HERO (BRZ) pulled hard along the inside chasing the leader, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
