Footnotes

HUSBAND'S FOLLY three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival then inside on the second turn, came out leaving that turn and three wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. DANDEREK (GB) stalked inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, took a short lead outside the pacesetter into the stretch, battled outside that one in the drive, inched away in deep stretch but was edged nearing the wire. BEACHCOMBING three deep leaving the chute, stalked outside a rival, went up three wide into and out of the second turn, bid between horses in deep stretch and continued willingly. SENATOR BOB sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail in the stretch and weakened late. SO ELITE saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the rest. SKY CAPE chased outside a rival or a bit

off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MAJOR MAGIC four wide in the chute, stalked outside a rival, dropped back between foes leaving the second turn and weakened. MIDNIGHT CROONER angled in and saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and weakened. JOE CARL angled in after the chute and saved ground to no avail. MALIBU AFFAIR chased outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn and failed to menace.
