Footnotes

STRINGS ATTACHED prompted the early pace three deep, stalked outside a rival on the turn, took the lead outside the pacesetter in upper stretch and kicked clear under some urging and steady handling. SUCCESS IN EXCESS sped inside to the early lead, set the pace along the rail, fought back in upper stretch but could not match the winner and just held second. GRISELLE, angled in and saved ground outrun early, swung out into the stretch and finished well. SULAYMONDO settled outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and had a mild late bid. GOLDEN TASSEL, steadied when crowded early, angled in and stalked the pace on the turn, swung out for room in upper stretch but weakened. LITTLE ITCH, saved ground off the pace, lacked room and steadied slightly nearing the stretch, remained inside and could not offer the necessary late kick. KNIFE FORK SWOON was shuffled a bit from between horses early, raced close up a bit off the rail, was outside a rival into the stretch and weakened. HEIDIJIM N' GRANT, angled in between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, dropped back, came four wide into the stretch and had little left. FARAJI, settled close up outside, was three deep on the turn and weakened.
