**Footnotes**

EASTSIDE BALLAD stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, bid between horses leaving the second turn, gained a short lead into the stretch, drifted in a bit past the eighth pole and held gamely under some urging and good handling late. SKIPPINGTOMONTANA chased outside a rival then bid three deep leaving the second turn to loom a threat but could not get by. JACKETTE saved ground stalking the pace, came out some into the stretch, steadied off heels past the furlong marker, angled out and could not offer the necessary late kick. LAURA'S MINSTREL came off the rail on the first turn, chased between horses on the backstretch and second turn and also lacked the needed rally. ASHLEY'S CLAN quickly sprinted clear, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail into the stretch, began to weaken nearing midstretch, steadied when crowded past the eighth pole and fell back. TRIXIE CHICK angled in and settled a bit off the rail, went three deep on the backstretch and second turn and did not rally. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run but made no change when they ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
