The host association's monies to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Breeders' Cup monies also correspondingly divided, provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert to the Fund. Weights Monday, August 25. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner by Breeders' Cup Ltd. Nominations closed Thursday, August 21, 2003 with 11.

Footnotes

JOEY FRANCO stalked the early pace off the rail, bid three deep leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, battled outside TASTE OF PARADISE on that turn, took a short lead into the stretch, inched clear in midstretch, then drifted in under right handed urging but proved best. REBA'S GOLD chased inside then a bit off the rail, moved up outside on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and continued willingly to be second best. GREY MEMO allowed to lag back and angled in early, continued inside to the second turn, came out leaving that bend and in the stretch and finished well to gain third late. TASTE OF PARADISE four wide early, stalked outside a rival, bid between horses on the backstretch and into the second turn, angled in and dueled inside the winner, could not match that one in the stretch and lost the show late. SEATTLE SHAMUS sped to the early lead and came a bit off the rail, dueled between foes leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. CAPTAIN SQUIRE stalked the pace inside, was in tight early on the second turn and also dropped back and weakened. CRAFTY C. T. chased off the rail then outside on the backstretch and second turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and had little left.
