CAJUN FLASH sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail under a snug hold while trying to get out, responded when a rival loomed on the turn, inched away, was hard ridden when drawing clear then was in hand late. SONG OF SUMMER settled outside a rival then angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up inside on the turn and into the stretch and was second best. MADAME PIETRA stalked the winner off the rail then bid outside that one on the turn, continued just behind off the inside into the stretch, was no match in the lane and lost the place. LUREFAN chased outside a rival then off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. GIVE PRAISE taken off the inside early, also chased outside a rival then off the rail without early speed, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
