TOP OF OUR GAME stalked the pace outside, went up between horses on the backstretch, bid outside the leader, took a short advantage leaving the second turn and drew clear under urging. MIMI'S CAFE between horses early, moved up three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn, drifted in a bit in deep stretch but gained the place. THEWHOLEBAG took a short early lead outside a rival, angled in leaving the first turn, set a pressured pace inside, could not match the winner in the stretch and lost second late. ELAINE'S ANGEL close up inside stalking the pace, clipped heels to drop back a bit on the backstretch, continued inside, was in a bit tight in deep stretch, came out and just missed third. STAR'S MILLENNIUM saved ground early, stalked three deep on the backstretch and second turn and lacked the needed rally. STETSON LADY pulled inside and steadied on the first turn, tugged her way between horses on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. A claim of foul by the rider of ELAINE'S ANGEL against MIMI'S CAFE and THEWHOLEBAG for alleged interference on the backstretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled ELAINE'S ANGEL was the cause of her own trouble.
