SUPER HIGH quickly sprinted to the front and angled in, set all the pace along the inside, kicked clear in the stretch and held gamely under urging. STETSON LADY stalked the winner off the rail throughout, loomed a threat leaving the second turn and into the stretch, could not match that one in the lane but was clearly second best. ELAINE'S ANGEL settled a bit off the rail then chased between horses on the backstretch and second turn, came out in midstretch and picked up the show. TOP OF OUR GAME stalked the winner off the inside to the stretch and lacked the needed response. MIMI'S CAFE saved ground in a good striking position to the stretch, remained inside and also lacked the necessary late kick. WARREN'S WHISTLE unhurried off the rail then outside on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. LIL SISTER STICH rank along the inside and steadied off heels in the run to the first turn, chased inside, came out a bit for the stretch and was not a threat. CONTINENTAL LU pulled a bit under a hold early, chased between horses, dropped back leaving the second turn and weakened. SMOKIN' CHARLOTTE chased three deep then four wide on the backstretch and second turn, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. CASTLING three deep on the first turn, drifted out some into the backstretch, dropped back, angled in on the second turn, then drifted out in the lane and was outrun.
