CHANT FOR GOLD took the early lead and angled in, dueled inside, fought off a rival after briefly being headed on the backstretch, turned back another bid to inch clear into the stretch and held on gamely under urging. STANTON stalked outside a rival or just off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, brushed with the show horse in deep stretch and continued willingly outside. I AM broke slowly, pulled between foes then chased toward the inside, moved up along the rail leaving the second turn, came a bit off the fence in the stretch, brushed with the runner-up in deep stretch and finished gamely between the top pair. PANAMA LANE veered out at the start, settled a bit off the rail, came outside a rival into the stretch, angled out in the lane and found his best stride late. SECRET STRANGER forced the early pace outside the winner, fell back and stalked on the backstretch, re-bid three deep then alongside the winner leaving the second turn, dropped back again between foes into the stretch and weakened. THREE ELEVENS saved ground chasing the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PARADISE COVE stumbled after the start, settled outside, came four wide into the stretch and also lacked the necessary response. MR. ONE PUTT hopped slightly at the start, was rank and steadied in tight on the first turn, tugged his way between foes and briefly headed the winner on the backstretch, dueled outside that one, dropped back leaving the second turn and gave way.
