THE USUAL Q. T. stalked inside then off the rail, bid alongside the runner-up on the backstretch, tracked again on the second turn, re-bid outside that one and took the lead in the stretch, inched away in midstretch and proved best under urging. BEST OF INTENTIONS pulled his way to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, inched away from the winner on the second turn, battled inside that one into the stretch, then was no match in the final furlong and just held second. PREMIERE FLYER settled off the pace inside, moved up along the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and just missed the place. BARBAROSSO chased three deep then outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was edged for a minor award. RENEGADE STORM stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went between horses on the second turn, angled back in entering the stretch and lacked the needed rally. STORMY GAME stalked outside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. WARREN'S TONY R. angled in and settled off the pace outside a rival, came out in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. DE CAR GUY pulled his way along to chase between horses or outside a rival, continued just off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally. ADAM SUANCES settled three deep then outside, came out four wide into the stretch and was not a factor. NOW AND ZEN bobbled at the start, went four wide into and on the first turn, chased outside, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
