Footnotes

CLEARANCE CLARENCE bobbled slightly at the start, recovered and sped to the lead on the inside, maintained the advantage throughout and held his foes safe in the final furlong. GRAND MANEUVER was bumped at the start, raced three wide into the first turn, chased inside a rival down the backstretch, came out some in the lane, could not catch the winner but was clearly second best. GRAYDLE'S RED saved ground around the first turn, chased on the inside down the backstretch, remained on the wood for the drive and could not mount a sufficient rally. UNBRIDLED SCORE broke out slightly at the start, was four wide into the first turn, moved up leaving the turn to press the pace down the backstretch, remained closest the winner at the top of the lane and weakened in the final furlong. NITRO POWER was bumped at the start, chased on the inside down the backstretch, swung out to the middle of the track for the drive and was not a threat. DRAFT ONLY broke slowly, chased outside a rival down the backstretch weakened on the turn and had nothing left for the drive.
