Footnotes

QUALITY ELUSION had speed three deep then stalked off the rail or outside a rival, angled in leaving the turn, came out in upper stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter, took the lead past the eighth pole and inched clear under urging. DANGER RANGER chased outside or off the rail, came out five wide into the stretch and continued willingly. MAY WEATHER had speed outside then stalked alongside a rival or off the inside, came four wide into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and bested the rest. SABE broke inward and a bit slowly, was sent up inside to duel for the lead, fought back in midstretch but weakened late. PEE H DEE saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and improved position. MUCHOS BESOS sent

between horses early, stalked inside, fell back some into the turn, came out into the stretch and again off heels in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. TRAWEEK had speed three deep then stalked outside a rival or off the rail, bid three wide again on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SHERIFF RYAN settled outside then alongside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and was not a threat. PETAK MOUNTAIN between horses early, settled off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and did not rally. SENSATIONAL JACOB wide early, settled off the rail then angled in for the turn and lacked the necessary response. RIDE CAPTAIN dueled between horses then outside a rival, battled between foes again on the turn and weakened in the stretch. DANGEROUS DUO a bit awkwardly into stride, settled off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response.
