### Footnotes

COMMON TRUST sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, turned back a rival's bid into the stretch and kicked clear under some urging and good handling. FILL THE TEMPLE stalked the pace inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and was second best. WINNING TACTICS wide early, chased outside a rival or off the rail, moved up outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch to loom a threat but settled for the show. HAY MAN DAN chased off the rail then inside on the second turn and in the stretch and was edged for third. SEMINOLE NATIVE angled in on the first turn and saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside and lacked the needed rally. SENIOR DISCOUNT between horses early, stalked outside a rival or a bit off the rail, went around a foe on the second turn, angled back in some and weakened. PREACHINTOTHECHOIR stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside the winner on the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and also weakened. RELATIVE OBSCURITY four wide into the first turn, settled off the rail, angled in some on the second turn and was outrun. JASJONJAKE four wide early, stalked three deep, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. BEAR CUB taken back and angled in outside a rival early, settled off the inside, came four wide into the stretch and failed to menace.
