FOLLOW THE RAINBOW stalked the pace off the rail then outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn, gained the advantage nearing the stretch, drifted out a bit into the lane, inched away and held on gamely under urging. CHIPS ARE DOWN stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn, was in a bit tight off the winner's heels in midstretch, came out some and continued willingly. KHYBER PASS sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened some but held third. SCOTTSBLUFF four wide early, stalked the pace three deep then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DOVER DERE tracked the pace between horses then inside on the second turn and could not summon the necessary response. BOGGY CREEK settled off the pace inside then a bit out from the rail on the backstretch, angled back in on the second turn and did not rally. ICED OUT also settled off the pace away from the rail, entered the stretch alongside a rival and failed to menace. AVANTI AVANTI unhurried outside a rival then off the rail, angled in some and dropped back on the second turn and was done early.
