Footnotes

IN THE CLUTCH settled a bit off the rail, went around a rival leaving the turn then cut the corner into the stretch, came out in upper stretch and finished strongly under steady handling to prove best. YES MASTER dueled between horses then outside a rival, kicked clear on the turn, continued a bit off the rail and was overtaken late. SWING YOUR PARTNER settled along the inside, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and picked up the show. NOTARIZED between horses early, chased outside a rival then off the rail, swung five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. PROUD TOWER TOO chased inside, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. CLEAR TALKER forced the early pace three deep then stalked outside a rival, came out into the stretch and weakened. CHAUNCEY stalked a bit off the rail, was in tight into the turn, split rivals on the bend and weakened in the stretch. TARIMBEIRO (BRZ) angled in and dueled inside, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
