SYNNIN AND GRINNIN had speed between horses then dueled inside, inched clear in the stretch and held under some late urging and steady handling. LIGHTMYFIREBABY chased off the fence then a bit off the rail on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and just got the place three deep on the line. ELETRO NUCLEAR (BRZ) stalked inside, came off the rail past the eighth pole and continued willingly between foes late. THAT'S HOT (IRE) a bit slow to begin, angled in and saved ground off the pace, rallied along the rail in the stretch and finished well. COCO BELLE between horses early, stalked inside, came out into the stretch and weakened some. BRIECAT stalked between horses to the stretch and lacked a rally. WHATSITGONNATAKE was in a good position stalking the pace three deep, came four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. PERFECTLY NATURAL had speed between foes then dueled outside the winner to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
