TAP TAP I WIN chased off the rail, angled in some for the turn, lacked room off heels into the stretch, came out in upper stretch, rallied to the lead under urging a sixteenth out and proved best. ISLAND RUN unhurried outside or off the rail, moved up leaving the turn, came four wide into the stretch and gained the place. MICKEY ROCKS steadied when squeezed at the start, chased off the rail then three deep, came out four wide into the stretch and bested the

others. WARRENS WILD THING also steadied when squeezed at the break, settled just off the rail, came out into and through the stretch and improved position. CACH D FISH had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, inched away and angled in on the turn, opened up in the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. QUINTONS SPEEDY broke inward, chased between horses then outside a rival, was between foes again leaving the turn and did not rally. ICE BALLETT chased off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, was in a bit tight nearing the stretch, came three deep into the lane and lacked the necessary response. JUST FOR US stalked off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the turn and weakened. BRUIN BENCH stalked between horses then outside a rival, was between foes again leaving the turn and also weakened. SIDANFRANK had good early speed and angled in and dueled inside, stalked along the rail on the turn and weakened in the lane. FIL'S REGENT broke outward, saved ground throughout to no avail. JOE BLACK SANDY stalked outside then four wide, continued three deep on the turn and into the stretch and had little left.
