## Footnotes

MIDSHIPMAN stalked off the rail then outside, went three deep on the turn and rallied under urging to get up late. CORONET OF A BARON had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, bid three deep into the stretch, gained a short advantage, drifted out in the final furlong and held on well but was caught late. STREET HERO chased between horses then three deep into and on the turn and into the stretch, angled inward past midstretch and closed willingly inside. SOUTHERN EXCHANGE went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and continued willingly but was outfinished. BELIEVE IN HOPE chased outside then four wide into and on the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. ESCALON bobbled slightly at the start, chased outside then between horses on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. BLAZING SPIRIT settled off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch and improved position in the stretch. WILD POSSE saved ground chasing the pace on the backstretch and turn and lacked the needed rally. KERWIN'S WAY dueled three deep, dropped back between foes on the turn and weakened. KELLY LEAK had good early speed and dueled between horses on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. MENSA HEAT chased between horses then a bit off the rail leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch.
