Footnotes

MARCADE four wide into the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn, took the lead outside a rival into the stretch, battled alongside that one through the drive and inched away late under left handed urging and strong handling. BERT'S TOO KINKY chased between horses then

off the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch and finished well late for the place. AFLEET HOPETOWN five wide into the first turn, pulled his way up three deep on the backstretch, bid outside rivals then between foes on the second turn, took a short lead leaving that turn, fought back inside the winner in the stretch, could not quite match that one in the final stages and just lost second. FORZA DEL DESTINO stalked between horses or off the rail, came out some on the second turn, angled in a bit leaving that turn, came out again in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WARREN'S JUAN pulled between foes then inside and was in a bit tight leaving the first turn, stalked inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and weakened. PANDA settled between horses then inside on the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn and was not a threat. JUICE COMMITTEE had speed between horses then angled in and dueled inside, dropped back nearing the stretch and weakened. CEE'S CLOSING TIME broke outward and a bit slowly, pulled between horses then chased three deep and lacked a response in the stretch. TRULY A DELIGHT pulled inside chasing the pace, dropped back on the backstretch and second turn and had little left for the stretch. EMINENT HONOR fractious in the post parade and warm up, pulled his way along three deep then dueled outside a rival, dropped back between horses on the second turn, angled in nearing the stretch and gave way. SENSE OF HONOR allowed to settle inside then off the rail, went up three deep into the second turn, angled in some leaving that bend and was not a threat.
