Footnotes

DEARLY CONCERNED bobbled slightly at the start, stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, rallied under some urging to the lead in deep stretch and won clear. INTENTIONAL pulled early and stalked inside then bid along the rail into and on the turn, dueled in a bit tight along the fence, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner late but gamely held second. CANADIAN PRIDE settled outside then off the rail, came four wide into the stretch, and finished well to get the show three deep on the line. RICKETYRACKETYRUSS hopped slightly in a bit of a slow start, settled off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and split foes at the wire. HUNTINGTON HARBOUR stalked inside, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. HANAKKUH sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then dueled outside a rival into and on the turn, also fought back in the stretch, was between foes past midstretch and weakened late. WOODMAN'S LASS pulled her way along to stalk the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally. MISS BUXLEY stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, continued alongside a rival into the stretch and weakened. WHISKERS AND RYE in a bit tight between horses early, chased three deep, came out five wide into the stretch and also weakened.
