FOR FILLIES, TWO-YEAR-OLDS (FOALS OF 2009) . By subscription of \$250 each, on or before June 3, 2011, the fee to accompany the nomination. For horses not nominated, supplementary nominations of \$10,000 each will close at the time of entry, Wednesday, August 31, 2011. All horses shall pay \$750 to pass the entry box and \$3,000 additional to start, with \$250,000 Guaranteed, of which \$150,000 to first, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$5,000 to fifth. . Weight 122 lbs.; Non-winners of \$50,000 allowed 2 lbs.; of a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; of a race other than claiming, 6 lbs.; High weights preferred. Total non-claiming purse earnings will determine the order of preference for fillies of equal status. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Friday, June 3, 2011 with 182. Supplementary Nominations closed, Wednesday, August 31, 2011 with 2.

WEEMISSFRANKIE chased off the rail then outside on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, gained the lead outside foes in midstretch and won clear under urging. SELF PRESERVATION bumped at the start and steadied sharply in tight in the opening strides, settled outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, angled out again in the drive and closed willingly for second. EMERALD GOLD pulled between horses then chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and edged rivals for the show. WILD TRUFFLES squeezed when bumped at the start, settled inside, came out a bit in upper stretch, split foes nearing midstretch, bid toward the inside and was outfinished. KILLER GRACES stalked a bit off the rail then inside, waited for room leaving the turn, came out three deep into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch and also was outfinished. SILENT SAGA angled in and chased inside, came a bit off the rail nearing the turn, went around a rival in midstretch then bid inside but could not quite summon the necessary response. DREAMCASTER (GB) prompted the pace three deep to the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and weakened. WOEBEGON stalked outside a rival then off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and also weakened. EVELYN'S DANCER had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. COUP DE COEUR broke out and bumped a rival, went up between horses to vie for command, battled between foes on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
