Footnotes

BUD I CRUSHED IT stalked on the inside down the backstretch, came off the rail leaving the quarter pole, entered the lane between horses, rallied three deep in the final furlong and was up on the wire. WOODMANS LUCK was unhurried into the first turn, chased off the rail down the backstretch, angled in on the second turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, rallied between horses, took a short lead at the sixteenth marker and was caught on the wire. UNSTOPPER TOPPER sped to the early lead into the first turn, set the pace to the stretch, was challenged leaving the furlong marker and weakened late on the inside. ACCELERANT saved ground around the first turn, angled outside on the backstretch, came into the stretch three wide, battled four deep in the final furlong and was edged for the show. CORNER OFFICE stalked the pace on the outside down the backstretch and between horses into the second turn, began to weaken leaving the quarter pole and gave way in the lane. GATHERATTHEALTER was caught three wide around the first turn, moved up three wide down the backstretch, began to weaken around the second turn and gave way in the stretch drive.
