NEVER SHEA NEVER settled a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and rallied under urging to get up late. HOUT BAY between foes early, angled in and chased a bit off the rail, split horses on the turn, came out in the stretch, bid three deep between horses to gain the lead in midstretch, inched away in deep stretch and just failed to hold off the winner. TOTALLY BLONDE stalked outside or off the rail, went three deep leaving the turn, came out in the stretch, bid four wide in midstretch and bested the rest. BILA SHAKA stalked outside on the backstretch and

turn, went four wide into he stretch and lacked the needed rally. ANNE'S SEVEN CATS sent between horses to duel outside a rival, battled between foes in midstretch and weakened. MY DIANE was sent along inside to stalk the pace, came out in the stretch and did not rally. BRAZILIAN CHARM had speed between foes then angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn to midstretch, then weakened. SECRET GENIUS broke a bit slowly and was squeezed back, settled off the rail, went between horses into the stretch and did not rally. MISS CALIFORNIA also off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out some in the stretch and was not a threat. HUNTINGTON HARBOUR settled outside then three deep into the turn, came four wide leaving the turn and into the stretch and was not a factor. PARDON MY EXCESS had speed three deep then stalked off the rail, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
