Footnotes

NATIVE TREASURE bobbled at the start, had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back in the stretch, inched away past midstretch, kicked clear under urging and held. THE HUMANCOMPLAINT four wide early, settled off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out in midstretch and finished well to just get the place. STRONG WIND dueled outside the winner, battled under urging in midstretch, had the rider lose the whip past the eighth pole, could not match that one in the final sixteenth and was edged late for second. BALLARD RULER between foes early, chased off the rail then three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LOVMEISTER also between horses early, stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. LIFE A RILEY saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
